

CODE OF PROFESSIONAL CONDUCT

In line with the objectives of the Institution, this code aims to promote Occupational Safety Health and Environment Management in Mauritius.

IOSHM Members shall: -

- Possess professional qualifications and exercise their duties as prescribed by law.
- Act with integrity and professionalism in the discharge of their duties towards the Safety, Health and Welfare of the personnel of their enterprises and the community at large.
- Strive to promote a safety culture within their organisation and to ensure effective management of risks at all levels.
- Make their professional judgement without being influenced by any conflict of interest, fear, favour or prejudice
- Maintain and develop their professional competence by keeping abreast of the latest technology.
- Foster and maintain good relationships with relevant Government Authorities and other agencies involved in the field of Occupational Safety, Health and Welfare.
- Build their professional reputation on merit and promote understanding, goodwill and cooperation among other members of the Safety and Health profession.
- Abstain from acting against the interest of the Institution or the other members and should not knowingly bring the Institution or its members into disrepute.
